GBP employs environmentally, socially and economically sustainable practices to meet the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs. This is accomplished by practicing and promoting resource conservation and stewardship ethics. GBP strives to maintain the quality of its packaging and container products without compromising recyclability and composability. GBP's commitment to socially sustainable development includes compliance with all employment laws, including: civil rights, equal opportunities, anti-discrimination and anti-harassment measures, workers compensation, and occupational health and safety programs.

GBP produces corrugated medium and linerboard at its Mill Divisions, corrugated boxes at its Corrugated Shipping Container Divisions, and folding cartons and paperboard packaging at its Folding Carton Division. The majority of fiber supplied to Green Bay Packaging divisions originates from forest and paper organizations that are independently certified to the SFI Standard. Additionally, GBP sustainably manages over 260,000 acres of forestland with its Fiber Resources Division.

GBP promotes the principles of sustainable development, with a focus on recycling and biodegradability, and strives for continuous improvement. To implement and achieve these objectives, GBP has developed and adopted appropriate programs, plans and procedures to guide its fiber procurement and product claims.
